Abstract

Abstract should contain the aim of the paper, main results of the research and short conclusion. Abstract should be no longer than 15 lines.

Keywords: list up to 5 keywords

Introduction

Recommendation for the length of the whole paper is 5 pages of A-4 format and Plenary papers up to 10 pages.

Material and methods

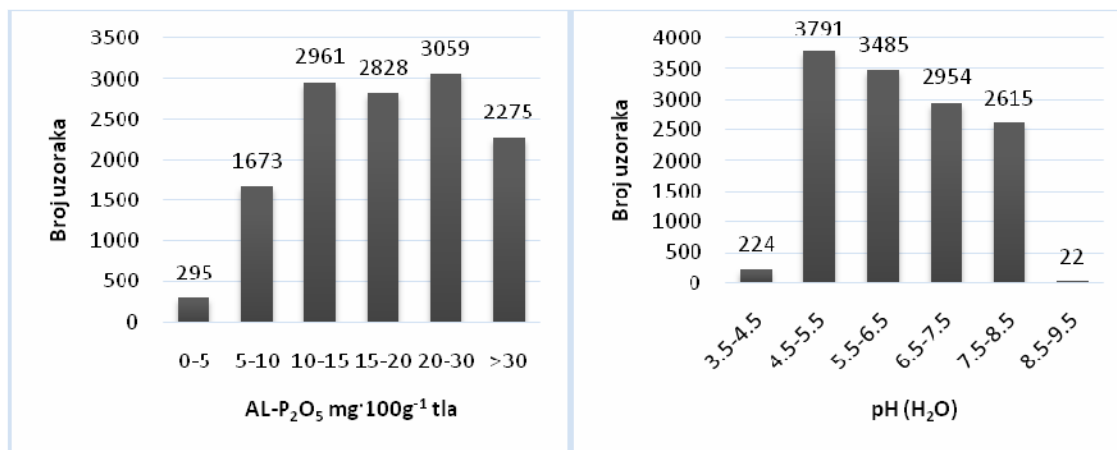
Margins 3.0 cm left, 2.5 cm up, down and right. Use single line space with justified. Text should be written in Microsoft Word for Windows, version 6.0 or higher, font Times New Roman, size 12 points. Title of the paper should be written in lowercase and bolded, size 14 points, centered. Authors (full names and surnames) in size 12 points. Address es in size 11 points, in italic. Subtitles in lowercase, bolded, size 12 points. For line spaces only key "Enter" should be used, as follows: before subtitle, between the title and authors list, between authors list and addresses, before table title and after the table. Do not indent the beginning of the paragraph, each paragraph should be separated by "Enter" key.

Results and discussion

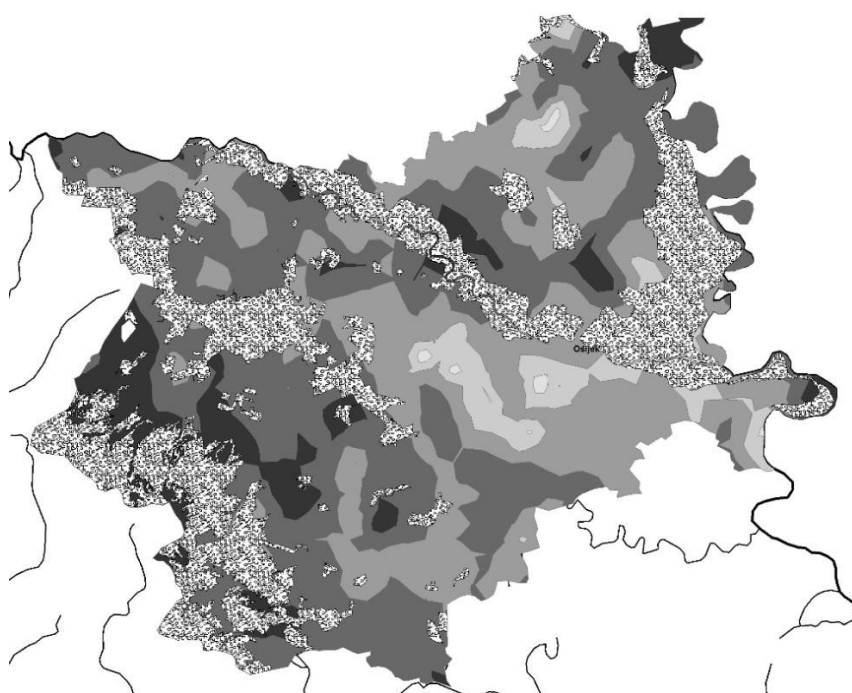
Within the text, graphic descriptions should be noted as follows: (Graph 1); (Picture 1); (Table 1). The citation system in text should be: author's surname and year of publication (e.g. Đurđević, 2010), if there are two authors, both surnames (e.g. Hansson and Westerberg, 2002), if more, than the first author's surname and abbreviation "et al." (e.g. Baban et al., 2009), and in case that author(s) surname is part of the sentence, only year of publication is in parenthesis (e.g. "Hall (2008) enlist..." or "Jug and Đurđević (2004) established..." or "Jurišić et al. (1999) founded...").

Table 1. Width of the table over the all paper length, only horizontal borders allowed, centred. Table's title aligned left at the top of the table. Bolded font for pointing out important values

Conclusion

The paper should contain: title, full authors' names and family names, addresses (each address in the next line), abstract, keywords, introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusion and literature. Papers of foreign authors shall leave space at the very last page for the title, abstract and keywords on Croatian language (translation will be done by Scientific board).
